Introduction of New NMTAC Member, Shannon Glass

Public Comments -- Charles Schmid expressed concern that the portion of the STO trail that will run on the West side of 305 from Knechtel Way to High School Road will reduce or eliminate the vegetation buffer on the west side of the highway. Don Willott suggested walking the alignment to assess.

City Engineer Report -- Chris Hammer

Island-wide Transportation Plan -- time spent reviewing and updating the City's non-motorized facilities maps, including bicycle lanes, connecting trails, separated pathways, designated trail zones, and greenways.

Committee Discussion

- Discussion of Potential Closure of Winslow Co-Housing Trail. Recommendation - As pertains to the Winslow Co-Housing Trail and in alignment with Committee goals, the NMTAC requests Helpline House & Winslow Co-Housing preserve gate access between their properties to maintain trail connectivity.
- Discussion of Bainbridge Landing SPR and SUB Applications. Recommendation - As pertains to Bainbridge Landing Proposed Development the NMTAC recommends:
  - Maintaining public non-motorized connectivity between Ferncliff & Cave
  - Encouraging the provision of public access through the development and into the existing Harbor Square development
  - Attempting to integrate pathways with existing Harbor Square development
- Discussion continued regarding using bonds to finance a significant number of Core 40 and other non-motorized improvements and the need to determine the total cost of the highest priority projects.
