

Ongoing Business

Frank Ostrander reported that he had contacted the Port of Kingston to obtain further information about the observation platform that is installed near their ferry dock. Still awaiting response. Frank also provided information on similar installations at Brownsville and Olympia.

The Committee reviewed the draft content that is due to be presented to City Council on January 24th and made some adjustments.

City had asked the Committee to provide a list of sites that may require further action to determine their status and develop next steps. The following sites had been referred to the City for attention: Site numbers: 52, 55, 34, 65, 46, 30 and 39. Details regarding the committee's requests regarding these sites will be forwarded to the Assistant City Manager's office.

The Committee provided feedback to the City regarding emails received from road-end neighbors at sites 52 and 30.

John Brownlow advised that he had received an email from a resident near the Ward Ave road-end requesting information about public access to the water now that the public float has been removed during the rebuild of the Eagle Harbor Marina. An email has been sent to the City requesting details of the public access arrangement or any discussions related to that.

The rebuild of Eagle Harbor Marina is proceeding rapidly. The entire marina (6 docks) will be completed in approximately 6 weeks. there is hope that the rebuild of the City Dock will not impact the boat launch for the entire summer period as may have been communicated. Tom Hudson advised that the rebuild of the Williamson Landing marina (25 slips) only took 2 weeks.
