**REVISED NOTICE OF DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)**


**The City of Bainbridge Island has received the following land use application:**

**Date:** June 14, 2013  
**Applicant/Owner:** City of Bainbridge Island- Nonmotorized Transportation Advisory Committee (NMTAC)  
**Project Name:** Nonmotorized Transportation Plan (NMTP) Comprehensive Plan Amendment - *Addition of NMTP Map E Amendments (see attached)*  
**File Numbers:** CPA 18420  
**Permit Request:** Comprehensive Plan Amendment application requesting amendments to the NMTP, a subelement of the Transportation Element.  
**Description of Proposal:** Amendments to the NMTP of the Comprehensive Plan to add the concepts of "complete streets" and the "Sound to Olympics Trail" to the goals and policies. This amendment also proposes changes to Map D of the NMTP to modify or add existing and planned facilities. A DNS was previously issued on March 29, 2013 for these amendments. This Revised DNS includes previously omitted changes to NMTP Map E (see attached).  
**Location of Proposal:** City of Bainbridge Island- this policy amendment would apply Citywide.  
**SEPA Decision:** The City of Bainbridge Island (lead agency) has determined that the proposal does not have a probable significant impact on the environment. This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340 (2). This determination was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public upon request. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2) c.
